



REGULATION
of the 49th Motocross Race
“VAIDAVAS KAUSS” (VAIDAVA CUP)

The race takes place in accordance with the Latvian Moto Sports Federation (LaMSF) Sport code, Ethics code, Motocross regulations and this following regulation. This is the C category race according to the LaMSF Sport code. The race is open.

1. Race time: **May 8, 2022.**
2. Place of race: Ape racetrack named after Arvids Levans, APE town.
3. Organiser: society “Motoklubs APE”, Registration No. 40008103434,
Street Jauna 1, Ape, LV-4337.
4. Racetrack: length – 1600m; width – from 6m to 12m; surface – sand, clay, black earth. Licence No.8251
5. Motorcycle classes (in accordance with the regulations of motocross race of LaMSF): **MX1, Veterans (riders with MX40+; MX45+ licences), Seniors (riders with MX50+ and MX55+ licences), „Zelta Mopēds” (Golden Moped).**
6. Official persons of the race:
 - Chief Referee: Raimonds Keišs

 - Head of the route: Jānis Jakovļevs
 - Head of the technical commission: Sandra Kikuča

7. Race: individual, in accordance with the LaMSF motocross regulations.
8. Race participants and equipment: in accordance with the LaMSF motocross regulations.
9. Registration of participants: May 8, 7.00 – 10.00 a.m.
10. Procedure of the race:
 - training: from 8.00 a.m.
 - the first start: at 11.15There are two rides for all motorcycle classes.
Length of rides:
MX1: 22 min. + 2 laps,
Veterans and Seniors: 15 min. + 2 laps,
„Zelta Mopēds”: 10 min. + 1 lap.
11. Defining results and awarding:
 - 11.1. Winners of “Vaidavas Kauss” in total evaluation are determined by the sum of points for two rides.
 - 11.2. In case of an equal sum of points, the won position for the second ride is taken into account.
 - 11.3. For each ride riders get points, in accordance with their position according to the table below:

11.4. For each ride riders of the MX1 class are paid monetary prizes in euros (EUR) in accordance with the regulation of the Latvian Championship.

11.5. In the total evaluation the winners of the 1st to 3rd positions in all motorcycle classes are awarded with cups and prizes.

11.6. All participants of „Zelta Mopeds” class receive medals of the „49th Vaidavas kauss” motocross.

12. As the “50th Vaidavas Kauss” is approaching, the new tradition continues – “Travelling Vaidava Cup for Team Evaluations”!

Team evaluation will be determined by the team's 3 best results in these Latvian Championship and "Vaidavas Kauss" classes: MX85, MX1, MX2, MX30+, MX-Veterans, MX-Seniors, Sidecar Open), under the condition that one result needs to be in MX1 or MX2 class! In case of an equal sum of points, the higher position is given to the team who had a higher position in MX1 class total evaluation (and then in MX2 class total evaluation).

12.1. The following can participate in the team evaluations: any club and/or legal person registered in Latvia or abroad, or any physical persons' self-organized entity created to participate in “Travelling Vaidava Cup for Team Evaluations”. Each rider can be counted only in one class.

12.2. Team applications need to be submitted in the race office if individual riders participate in the team evaluations or the riders are from different clubs. If the team membership is in accordance with the record in the licence, then it is not necessary to submit an additional team application.

13. Participation fees are determined in accordance with the regulations of the Latvian Championship.

13.1. If the participant is registered for the race until 6 May at. 23:59 - 50 €.

13.2. For participants who have not made a previous registration - 60 €.

13.3 . "Golden moped" for class participants - 19 €.

14. Riders must be licensed and insured against motocross accidents. A one-time licence fee - in accordance with the LaMSF member fee regulation of 2022.
